- 1. One (1) scholarship of \$1000.00 US is awarded to High School graduating students, ONLY, entering undergraduate studies. This is awarded by the AHEPA EDUCATIONAL NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM for the DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS and is designated as the NICHOLAS KOUNARIS, P.A. MARGARONIS, SAM NAKOS, WILLIAM THOMAS or CARLOS T. TOURIS SCHOLARSHIP. Applicant must be a member of the AHEPA Family (Order of AHEPA, Daughters of Penelope, Sons of Pericles or Maids of Athena) in good standing for the years 2014 and 2015, verified by their Local Chapter. If not a member, then the applicant's Parent(s) / Guardian(s) must be a member of the AHEPA Family in good standing for the years 2014 and 2015, verified by their Local Chapter.
- 2. Three (3) scholarships of the AHEPA Family Beaver District No. 23, of \$1,000.00 each, are offered to students of a government accredited post-secondary educational institution, a university, community college or CEGEP, or a student who has been accepted by such institution, provided that proof of acceptance is also submitted.

Deadline for application: May 5, 2015

No application will be accepted if it is not **postmarked** by the deadline.

AHEPA and DAUGHTERS of PENELOPE DISTRICT No. 23 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. The applicant:

- i. Can be male or female and be of Greek descent (from father or mother) and reside within the District 23 domain.
- ii. It is preferable that the applicant be affiliated with the AHEPA Family and/or is a child or grandchild of a member of one of the above, (a **must** for an applicant for the AHEPA EDUCATIONAL NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP). Membership to be considered must be in good standing at least for the years 2014 and 2015, verified by the Local Chapter of the member.

2. The applicant must be:

- i. A student of a government accredited post-secondary educational institution, a university, community college or CEGEP (Quebec), or
- ii. A student who has been accepted by such institution, provided that proof of acceptance is also submitted, or
- iii. A student who is in the process of completing CEGEP (Quebec) and has applied for admission to a government accredited post-secondary educational institution, provided that proof of application is also submitted.
- 3. The applicant must submit the following documents:
 - i. An **original copy** of his/ her **transcript** for the most recent year completed.
 - ii. A **letter of recommendation** from the principal or guidance counselor of the high school from which he/she graduated, except where the applicant is already a student at a post secondary institution, as defined above, in which case a professor's letter is preferred.
 - iii. In the case of Article 2 ii. above, **proof of acceptance is required** and in the case of Article 2 iii. above, proof of application for admission is required.
 - iv. A typewritten **statement** of no more than 500 words by the student describing his/her educational and career goals.
- 4. Applicants who are affiliated with the AHEPA Family, as defined above in 1ii, should contact the local Chapter President of AHEPA or D.O.P. to **endorse their application** before mailing it to the District No 23 V.P. Education at the above address. Candidates not affiliated with the AHEPA Family can mail their application before the required deadline at the above address ensuring that all pertinent documents are attached with the application.
