### **Qualifications**

Applications will be assessed on a grid totaling a maximum of 100 points. A maximum of 80 points will weigh in on academic achievement, 10 points for volunteer or community work, and 10 points on the submitted essay. An extra point will be awarded to an applicant who is presently a member of one of the four orders of the Ahepa Family.

1. The applicant can be male or female.
2. The applicant must be of Hellenic origin (either mother or father)
3. The applicant must be a resident of Quebec
4. The applicant must be enrolled in a full-time program in a government accredited University
5. A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or equivalent must have been achieved in the last semester as calculated from the official transcripts submitted with this application.
6. A 500-word typed personal statement (In English, French or Greek) outlining the applicant's personal goals, career objectives, and the role that his/her Greek heritage played in their upbringing.
7. Letters supporting volunteerism and community service can be submitted
8. A photograph of the applicant.

Note: Past Penelope Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply for another scholarship.

**Completed application and required documents must be submitted by May 15, 2019.**
